



Dear Dimitris,

On behalf of the Hungarian 470 Class Association and Tihanyi Hajós Egylet (Organizing Authority) we would like to place a bid for the 470 Youth World Championship for the year 2020 or 2021 or 2022 and/or the 470 Masters Cup 2020 or 2021 or 2022.

Tihanyi Hajós Egylet (THE) was founded in 2000 and is located on the most spectacular location of the lake Balaton. Our main activity is youth sailing, we have 70 kinds in Optimist, Laser, 420, 470 and Finn classes. In summer we are organizing sailing camps for more than 350 kids annually. The Club has about 200 members, and our annual turnover is about 200.000 EUR. In 470 we have 3 junior couple and most of our coaches are interested to participate as a sailor on the masters event.

Our basis is a peaceful marina, where we have berths for 75 yachts, newly built clubhouse, including all the race office facilities, youth clubhouse and beds for 50 sailors. We have 2 large (30 ft and 25 ft) motorboat, and 10 RIB-s and all the necessary assets for organizing events like the proposed.

We have wide experience organizing international regattas, we were hosting the 470 Masters Cup 2 times (2002, 2015) Finn Masters EC 3 times (last in 2017: 89 boats), Cadet EC.

You can see more information about our club on the www.thesail.hu page, and

Lake Balaton is a nice, clean sweet water lake, 2-5 meter depth. In summer the water temperature is between 22-25 C. The wind is variable, in one week sailors could sail in very different conditions here. (Bft 2-6)

Our proposed times are May, June and September. July and August is too crowded and we have not so reliable wind conditions in the midsummer.

We declare that:

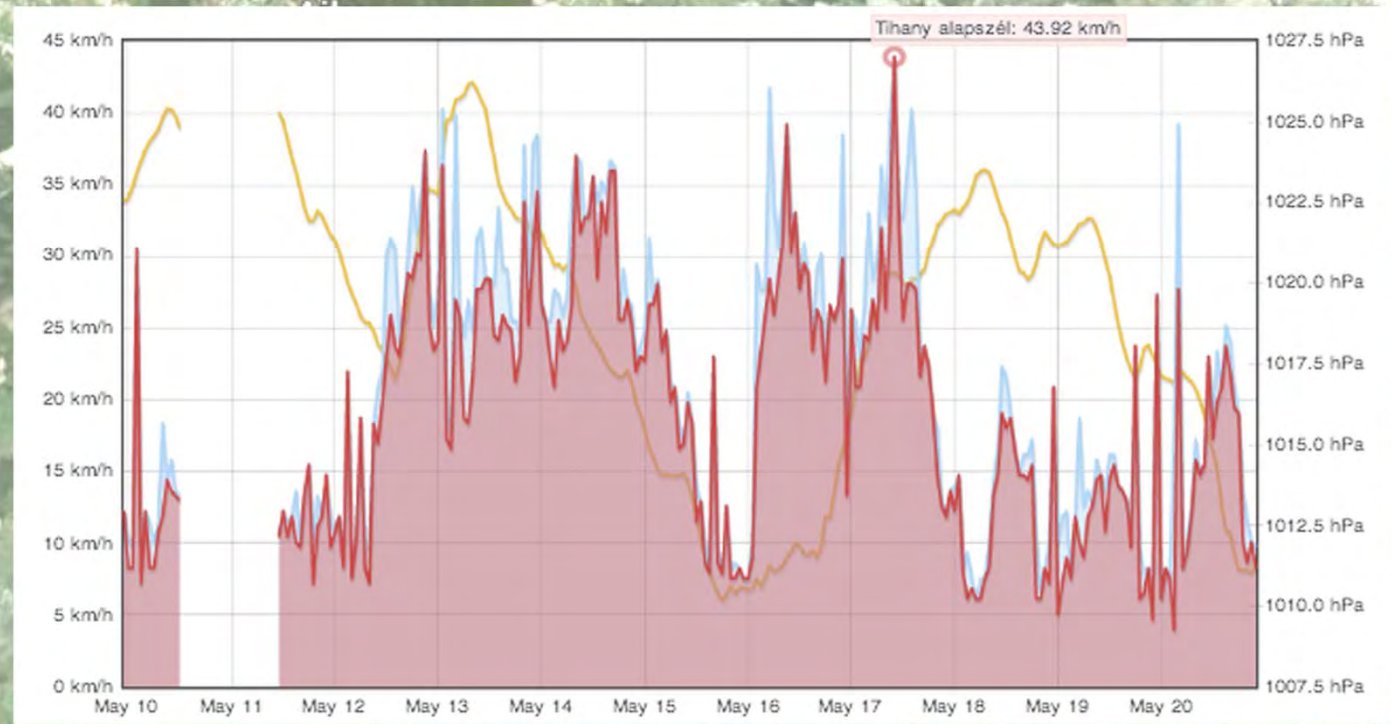
