1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 The Yachting New Zealand Safety Regulations Part 1 shall apply
- 1.3 For protests where a rule of Part 2 or Rule 31 is alleged to have been broken an arbitration hearing will be offered prior to any formal hearing.
- 1.4 Appendix P may apply.

2 ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the 470 class that comply with the class rules and whose owner(s) are current financial members of their respective Class Associations.

- 3.3 Late entries, accompanied by the contest entry fee plus the late entry fee may be accepted at 470 National Champs 2016 – Manly Sailing Club Final

the race committee's discretion until 0800 hours Friday 22nd January 2016.

- 3.4 To be eligible to compete in this event each entrant and crew member shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the entrant and crew member's national authority.

5.4 Racing schedule:

Friday 22 nd January 2016	4 races back to back.
Saturday 23 rd January 2016	4 races back to back.
Sunday 24 th January 2016	2 races back to back.

- 5.5 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race of the contest each day is 11.00 hours.

- 5.6 On Sunday 24th January 2016 no warning signal will be made after 1700 hours.

6 MEASUREMENTS

- 6.1 Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate if requested.

7 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at registration on Friday 22nd January 2016 at the Manly Sailing Club.

8 VENUE & RACING AREA

The regatta will be based at Manly Sailing Club and sailed on the waters of the Hauraki Gulf off Manly Beach

9 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be Triangle / Windward Leeward or Windward Leeward or Trapezoid.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

11 SCORING

Five races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 to 10 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

12 LAUNCHING

Unless otherwise directed by the Organising Authority, all competing boats and equipment shall be launched and retrieved from Manly Sailing Club.

13 RADIO COMMUNICATION

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones.

14 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: The winner will be awarded the 2016 NZ National Champion Title and receive the NZ National Class Association Trophy.

15 DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.

16 INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of NZD \$1,000,000 per incident or the equivalent.
