



NOTICE OF RACE

470 CLASS ASIAN CHAMPIONSHIP 16-21 DECEMBER 2019

The Chinese Yachting Association and the International 470 Class Association are pleased to invite 470 sailors to take part in the:

**2019 470 Asian Men Championship,
2019 470 Asian Women Championship**

And

2019 470 Asian Open Week,
In Shenzhen, CHINA from 16-21 December

The 2019 470 Asian Men & Women Championships shall be also the Asian Continental Qualifier Event for the 470 Class Men & Women events for the Tokyo 2020 Olympic Games.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The Championship will be governed by the rules as defined in *Racing Rules of Sailing* (RRS).
- 1.2 No National Authority prescriptions will apply.
- 1.3 No Class Rule variations will apply.
- 1.4 In all rules governing this championship:
 - 1.4.1 [NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1(a).
 - 1.4.2 [SP] denotes a rule which a standard penalty may be applied by the Race Committee without a hearing, or a discretionary penalty applied by the Protest Committee with a hearing. This changes RRS 63.1 and A5.
- 1.5 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.



2. [DP] [SP] [NP] ADVERTISING AND BOW NUMBERS

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display bow numbers and / or advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority. If this rule is broken, World Sailing Regulation 20.9.2 applies.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to boats of the 470 Class and to competitors who comply with World Sailing Regulation 19 – Eligibility Code.
- 3.2 Eligible boats shall fill in the relevant “Entry Form” attached at the end of the NoR, and pay the corresponding entry fees.
- 3.3 Entries sent after 20 November 2019, but on or before 1 December 2019, will be accepted with the required entry fees. Late entries received after 1 December 2019 will be accepted only at the discretion of the Organizing Authority, whose decision shall be final.
- 3.4 Competitors under 18 years of age shall present a signed and completed parent (or guardian) consent and declaration form at on-site registration. They may choose to download their Entry Form from their Sailor Account once they have completed their entry and entry fee payment to the Championship.
- 3.5 Support Team members (Coaches, team leaders and representatives from participating nations) are requested to fill in the entry form attached at the end of the NoR. Entry fees shall be paid direct to the Organizing Authority during on-site registration.
- 3.6 Entry quotas are limited to 5 boats per country in the 2019 470 Asian Men & Women Championships respectively. Entry is unlimited in the 2019 470 Asian Open Week.

4. CLASSIFICATION

- 4.1 No classification requirements will apply (see RRS 79).

5. FEES

- 5.1 The entry fee is EUR 250 per boat.

Entry fees to be paid by Support Teams are EUR 75 per person and will be paid directly to the Organizing Authority at on-site registration.

These entry fees include all collective services provided by the Organizing Authority, such as social events, boat park facilities, toilets and showers.

6. CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

6.1 Men, Women and Open Week fleets shall race separately. The Championships will be competed in single fleet format with 11 races in each fleet.

7. SCHEDULE

7.1 Schedule of races:

7.2 No warning signal will be given after 16:00 on the last racing day.

7.3 No more than three races shall be sailed each day.

8. [DP] [NP] MEASUREMENT

8.1 Each boat shall produce a valid Measurement Certificate, including the completed Measurement Form, at the time of pre-race equipment inspections. If the completed Measurement Form is a photocopy, its authenticity shall be confirmed with an original stamp and signature from the issuing authority. If a boat is to produce a measurement certificate in accordance with RRS 78.2, she shall do so before 10:00 on 17 December 2019.

8.2 In accordance with RRS78, competitors are responsible for maintaining their boat in accordance with the Class Rules (for the purpose of RRS 78, competitors are considered to be the owners). Equipment checks may be performed at random during the regatta.



9. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

9.1 Sailing Instructions will be available during registration at the Race Office and at the Championship website. Other documents governing the event will be published with the Sailing Instructions.

10. VENUE

10.1 The regatta site is located at:

Sevenstar Yacht Club
Dapeng Peninsula, Sevenstar Bay.

The navigation coordinates are 22°34'10" north latitude and 14°31'55" east longitude.

10.2 Appendix 1 shows the location of the regatta site and the racing area

11. THE COURSES

11.1 The courses will be Windward/Leeward or Trapezoid.

12. PENALTY SYSTEM

12.1 RRS Appendix P, *Special Procedures for RRS 42*, will apply.

12.2. RRS P2.3 will not apply and RRS P2.2 is changed so that it will apply to any penalty after the first one.

13. SCORING

13.1 RRS Appendix A will apply.

13.2 There will be 11 races for each fleet. At least 5 races are required to be completed to constitute the respective Championships.

13.3 Discards

- When fewer than 3 races have been completed, a boat's series score is the total of her race scores from all races,
- When 3 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score is the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

14. [DP] [NP] SUPPORT TEAMS

14.1 All Support Team members shall be registered with the Organizing Authority and will be required to comply with local legislation and event Support Team Regulations. The Organizing Authority may refuse registrations and accept later registrations at their sole discretion.

14.2 Registered Support Team boats shall:

- a) fly a flag with their three letter national code (see RRS G1.1) clearly displayed, or shall carry a sticker of their three letter national code on each side of the boat or engine. The minimum height for the letters shall be 200 mm. The flag or stickers will not be provided by the Organizing Authority.



b) fly a numbered identifier flag which will be provided by the Organizing Authority during registration.

14.3 Registered Support Team boats shall act as assistance / rescue boats in case of need and shall comply with any instructions given by the Race Committee or the Organizing Authority.

14.4 All Support Team boats shall have third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of EUR 500,000 or equivalent per incident.

15. [DP] [NP] BERTHING

When berthed, boats shall be kept in their assigned place at the boat park.

16. PRIZES AND TITLES

16.1 The first crews of the final official ranking lists of the Men and Women Asian Championships will be declared:

“470 Class Men’s Asian Champion”

and

“470 Class Women's Asian Champion”

16.2 Medals will be awarded to the first, second and third place crews of the Asian Championships by the International 470 Class Association.

16.3 Prizes will be awarded to the top-three placed crews of the Open Week by the Organizing Authority.

17. RISK STATEMENT

Competitors and support team members participate in the Championship entirely at their own risk and they are reminded of the provisions of RRS 4, Decision to Race. Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:

17.1 They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;

17.2 They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;

17.3 They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;

17.4 By participating in any race, they are satisfied that their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;

17.5 The provision of a race management team, safety boats, judges and other officials and volunteers by the organizer does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;

17.6 The provision of safety boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances.

17.7 They will familiarize themselves with any venue/event specific risks, adhere to rules and information produced for the venue/event and they will attend any venue/event safety briefings.

18. [DP] [NP] MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT

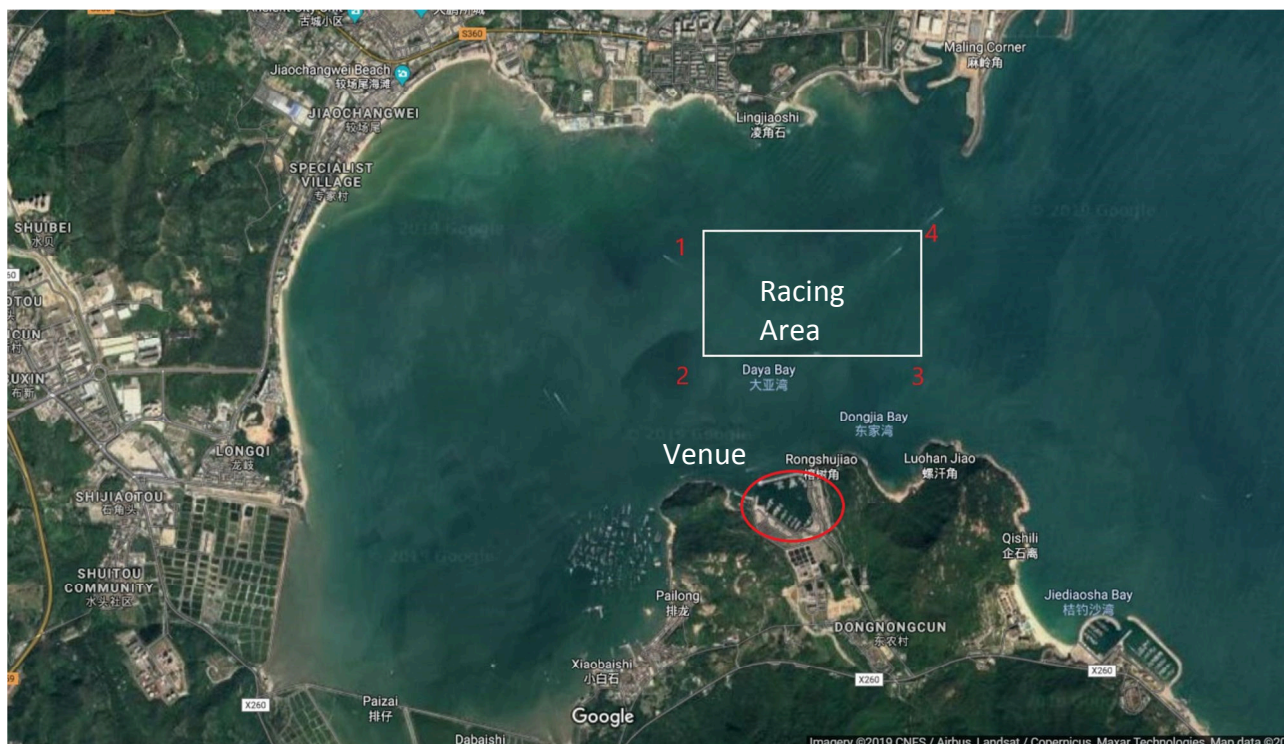
18.1 By participating in the Championship, competitors automatically grant to the International 470 and 420 Class Associations and to the Organizing Authority and their sponsors, the right in perpetuity to make, use and show, from time to time at their discretion, any motion pictures and live, taped or filmed television and other reproductions of the athlete during the period of the competition without compensation.

18.2 Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment or positioning equipment as specified by the organizing authority and in accordance with Class Rules.

19. INSURANCE

19.1 Each 'person in charge' (see RRS 46) shall hold a valid insurance certificate showing proof of third-party liability with a minimum coverage per incident of EUR 500,000 or equivalent. The Organizing Authority is not responsible for verifying the status or validity of such certificates.
