ARENAL TRAINING CAMPS TROPHY

From 10th to 13th MARCH

NOTICE OF RACE

The ATC TROPHY will be held from 10th to 13th March 2016, on waters of Arenal (Bay of Palma), organised by the CLUB NAUTIC ARENAL- MALLORCA- SPAIN.

1. RULES

- 1.1 The event will be governed by the rules as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).
- 1.2 For fleet racing, RSS Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, will apply.
- 1.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence
- 1.4 The prescriptions of the Royal Spanish Sailing Federation will not apply.
- 1.5 There are no weight controls.
- 1.6 There are no limits in the number of sails to use.
- 1.7 The coaches are allowed to film the races, (always with the previous permission of the teams to be filmed) but are forbidden to maintain conversations with the crews during the race. Where there is a conflict between the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions, the latter shall prevail.

2. ADVERTISING

Boats may be required to display bow numbers and advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

3. CLASSES TO COMPETE

The ATC TROPHY is reserved to the **Olympic Classes:** 470 M – W, Finn, 49er, 49erFx, Laser, Laser Radial, and RS:X and Nacra 17

4. ELIGIBILITY

ISAF Eligibility shall apply. Each athlete shall be registered as an ISAF Sailor on the ISAF website: www.sailing.org/isafsailor





5. ENTRIES

5.1 Entries must be made online before 7th March 2016 on the Official regatta website http://trophy.arenaltrainingcamps.com

5.3 The entry fees are:

BOATS training in the Arenal Training Camps: No entry fee

ALL BOATS just entering the regatta: 20€ per boat

6. REGISTRATION OF COMPETITORS

6.1 Each competitor shall personally register and sign the registration form at the Race Office before 18:00 hrs on 10th March 2016.

6.2 Registration is conditioned to the presentation before that time of the following documents:

6.2.1 A valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 300.500 Euros.

6.2.2 For Spanish competitors only, the RFEV 2016 license.

7. SCHEDULE

Races are scheduled as follows:

9 races are scheduled. One discard is allowed when 5 or more races are sailed.

On the last day of racing races will not start after 15.30h.

A Medal race will not be scheduled in this regatta.

8. RACING FORMAT

Courses will, as far as possible, be of the same configuration as those proposed for the 2016 Olympic Regatta. Races will be planned to be of similar duration.

9. SCORING

The RRS Appendix A and the "Low Point Scoring System" described in RRS A4.1 shall apply with the amendments described in the Sailing Instructions.

10. MEASUREMENT

Measurement checks can be made.





11. JURY

A National Jury will be appointed in accordance with RRS.

12. DISCLAIMER

All those taking part in the event do so at their own risk and responsibility. The Organising Committee or any part involved with the organisation of the event disclaim any and every responsibility whatsoever for loss, damage, injury or inconveniences that might occur to persons and goods, both ashore and at sea as a consequence of participation in the races covered by this Notice of Race.

Attention is drawn to the RRS Fundamental Rule 4 – Decision to Race, which states: "The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone"

13. PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top three competitors in each Class in the overall results.

14. SOCIAL EVENTS

Every day after the races, complimentary food and drinks will be available for all the participants.
