Subject Header: <b>Organisation of Master's Cup Affairs</b>	
Context: If referencing existing 470 Class Rules, Championship Manual or other documentation please reference the documentation.  Currently, any modifications to the Master's Cup Manual must be discussed and approved at the GAM. The GAM is generally held at the location of a convenient European or World Championship event where there are many senior and/or junior sailors and coaches available to represent their NCA's, but where there are few Masters sailors. The discussion and voting of Master's affairs at GAM is therefore made by sailors who are not directly concerned by the subject.	
Proposal Text:  The proposal is that matters concerning Masters should be handled by a Masters Committee which reports and seeks validation of the Management Committee, allowing a more flexible and pragmatic approach to dealing with matters relating to Masters. Organisation of this Committee and its relation to the 470 Internationale is proposed as per the attached Memorandum of Understanding, which was drafted and approved by the current Masters Representatives at Oberhofen last summer.
